

2011 Outcast Red Snapper Tournament Rules

1. All fish must be caught during the specified dates of the tournament, **June 1, 2011 – end of federal Red Snapper season.**
2. Registration will continue throughout the dates of the tournament. Entry fees: Until May 26, 2011 is \$93.02 + tax = \$100.00; after May 26, 2011 the fee is \$116.28 + tax = \$125.00. Entries received on or after June 1, 2011 must wait 24 hours to weigh a fish.
3. Tournament hours and dates are from 12:01 a.m. Wednesday, June 1, 2011 through 8:00 p.m. on the final day of the federal Red Snapper season.
4. The awards checks will be available on the 5th day after the end of the tournament.
5. Official weigh station will be OUTCAST FISHING and HUNTING.
6. Winners will be determined by weight; in case of a tie, the first fish weighed in will be determined the winner.
7. **Decision of the tournament committee is final.** Violation of any of the tournament rules will subject the boat to disqualification from the tournament without refund.
8. Any protest must be presented to the weigh-master within 24 hours of the weigh-in of the fish in question. No protest will be accepted after 9:00 p.m. on the final day of fishing. A \$500 (cash only) protest fee must accompany the protest application. In the event the protest is upheld, the fee will be refunded. If the protest

9. A polygraph examination may be required and must be passed in a conclusive manner. Failure to submit to such an examination will result in disqualification of the entrant at the sole discretion of the tournament committee.
10. All fish must be in acceptable condition. The tournament chairman or any committee member reserves the right to reject any fish entry because of poor condition, mutilation, or being frozen. The condition of the fish will be left up to the scrutiny of the committee. Their decision is final.
11. All fish must be caught on ROD and REEL. Fish caught by bicycle rigs, spears, traps, nets, or any other entangling device will be disqualified.
12. All fish weighed must meet the minimum federal and state size requirements.
13. All fish weighed may be subject to random gutting. Failure to allow a tournament committee member to gut a fish will result in the disqualification of the fish in question.
14. **Only one prize per boat in the overall division and only one prize per boat per week.**
15. The Outcast Red Snapper Tournament is under obligation and will report any violation of the minimum size lengths and possession limits of all fish involved..
